Purpose of the Role:

The Volunteer Community Fundraiser will play a key role in supporting ADSS's fundraising efforts by engaging with the local community, raising awareness, and supporting fundraising activities to support our mission. This role offers an opportunity to make a meaningful impact in the community, gain experience in fundraising, and build strong connections with individuals who are passionate about making a difference.

Key Responsibilities:

- **Community Engagement:** Actively engage with individuals, businesses, and groups within the community to raise awareness about the organization's work and fundraising needs by attending meetings, delivering presentations and hosting awareness stands.
- **Donation Solicitation:** Help solicit monetary donations, in-kind gifts, and event sponsorships from community members, businesses, and other stakeholders.
- **Promotional Outreach:** Distribute promotional materials, represent the organisation at local events, and engage in community networking to raise awareness about ongoing and upcoming campaigns.
- **Team Collaboration:** Work closely with other volunteers, staff, and community partners to achieve fundraising goals and ensure that events and campaigns run smoothly.
